a: What it is

• Lies at the heart of biblical relationships of which the primary aim is to promote the worship, i.e. the awe and reverence of Christ / the fear of God.

Ephesians 5:21

²¹ submitting to one another in the fear of God.

Hebrews 12:28 NIV

²⁸ Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so **worship God acceptably** with reverence and awe,

• A trust relationship in which partners assume responsibility for each other's spiritual well-being and eternal destiny

¹⁵ Look after each other so that none of you fails to receive the grace of God. Watch out that no poisonous root of bitterness grows up to trouble you, corrupting many.

• Only possible within a 'gossip-free' environment – i.e. one of trust, where respect and confidentiality, loyalty and unity are esteemed values.

c: In practice

Ephesians 4:25 NIV

²⁵ Therefore each of you must **<u>put off falsehood and speak truthfully</u>** to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body.

- It is only as good as the information on which it is based. Accountability without full disclosure is a waste of time.
- Happens on two levels: the group and the fixed partnership.

- Requires a formal commitment to be honest and transparent to grow in trust.
- Is focused on the primary/ root issues of life.

¹⁰ For the **love of money** is a **root of all evils**; it is through this craving that some have been led astray and have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves through with many acute [mental] pangs.

- How's your pursuit of destiny (i.e. current assignments) ? are you on schedule?
