B How to receive 1. Practicing on God Psalm 103:1-2 ¹ Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! ² Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits

B How to receive 2. Give it away to others Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom...

B How to receive 2. Give it away to others Luke 6:38 ...For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

B How to receive 3. Engaging blessed people Genesis 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

1. "bless and keep"

To speak life over someone's existence, i.e. their protection and preservation

2. "make his face shine"

To know the confidence and security that comes from His approval/ smile of/ upon you as a person

3. "be gracious" To know the joy of His forgiveness and unconditional acceptance

4. "turn his face toward you" To experience His prospering of one's contribution and aspiration

5. "give you peace"
