


Then, six days before the Passover, Jesus came to Bethany, where Lazarus was who had been dead, [a] whom He had raised from the dead. There they made Him a supper;

and Martha served, but Lazarus was one of those who sat at the table with Him.






#### John 12:1-2 (NKJV)

<sup>2</sup>There they made Him a supper; and Martha served, <u>but Lazarus</u> was one of those who <u>sat at the table with Him</u>.






#### **John 12:3 (NKJV)**
