# Rely On

# John 10: 26-28

26 But you do not believe and trust and rely on Me because you do not belong to My fold [you are no sheep of Mine]. 27 The sheep that are My own hear and are listening to My voice; and I know them, and they follow Me. 28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never lose it or perish throughout the ages. [To all eternity they shall never by any means be destroyed.] And no one is able to snatch them out of My hand.

#### 1 Cor 1: 20

# Safe Wisdom

#### 1 Cor 2: 6

Yet when we are among the full-grown (spiritually mature Christians who are ripe in understanding), we do impart a [higher] **wisdom** (the knowledge of the divine plan previously hidden); but it is indeed not a **wisdom** of this present **age** or of this **world** nor of the leaders and rulers of this age, who are being brought to nothing and are doomed to pass away.

# For this **world's wisdom** is foolishness (absurdity and stupidity) with God, for it is written, He lays hold of the wise in their [own] craftiness;

# Safe Wisdom

#### 2 Cor 1: 12

[ Paul's Change of Plans ] For our boast is this, the testimony of our conscience, that we behaved in the world with simplicity and godly sincerity, not by earthly wisdom but by the grace of God, and supremely so toward you.
