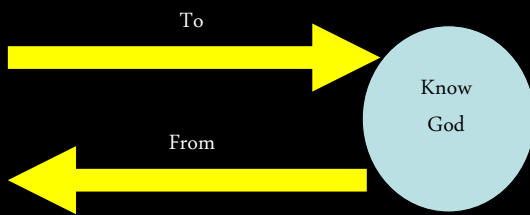

Dan 11: 32

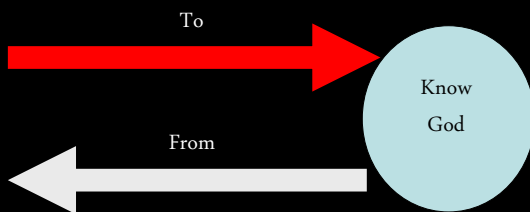
Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but the people who **know** their **God** shall be strong, and carry out great **exploits**.

Mega Grace

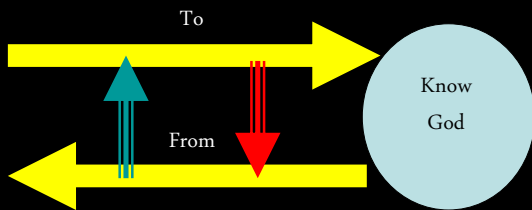
Acts 4: 33
