



Broken families stats

- 63% of suicides comes from fatherless homes.
- 80% of rapists motivated by displaced anger come from fatherless homes.
- 70% of juveniles in state operated institutions come from fatherless homes
- 40% of all children do not live with their biological fathers.


Broken families stats

- 85% from behavioural problems comes from fatherless homes.
- 90% of homeless children come from fatherless homes.
- 71% of children who do not finish school come from fatherless homes.

Deut 6:1-4

“Now this is the commandment, and these are the statutes and judgments which the Lord your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe them in the land which you are crossing over to possess, 2 that you may fear the Lord your God,
