




## Matthew 5 vs 13 – 16:

<sup>16</sup> In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven"






## John 17 vs 15 -18

"......<sup>18b</sup>I have sent them into the world"




"15Do not love the world or anything in the world."

"13 But if salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men."






You (plural) are the salt of the earth.
