Efesiërs 3:8-10

Exegesis:

- is the careful, systematic study of the Scripture to discover the original, intended meaning;

Hermeneutics:


- seeking the contemporary relevance of ancient texts;
- To ask the questions about the Bible's meaning in the “here and now”



Eisegesis:

- o The opposite of exegesis, meaning “take out of” is eisegesis meaning “to put into”
- o Exegesis embodies all that is good in Biblical interpretation and eisegesis all that is bad;
- o All false interpretation of the Bible is eisegetical and imposes the reader’s biases and misconceptions on the text.

As dit is om onderrig te gee, laat ons onderrig gee. ⁸As dit is om mense te bemoedig, laat ons hulle bemoedig. As ons gee, laat dit sonder bybedoelings wees. As ons leiding gee, dan met toewyding. As ons ander help, dan met blymoedigheid.

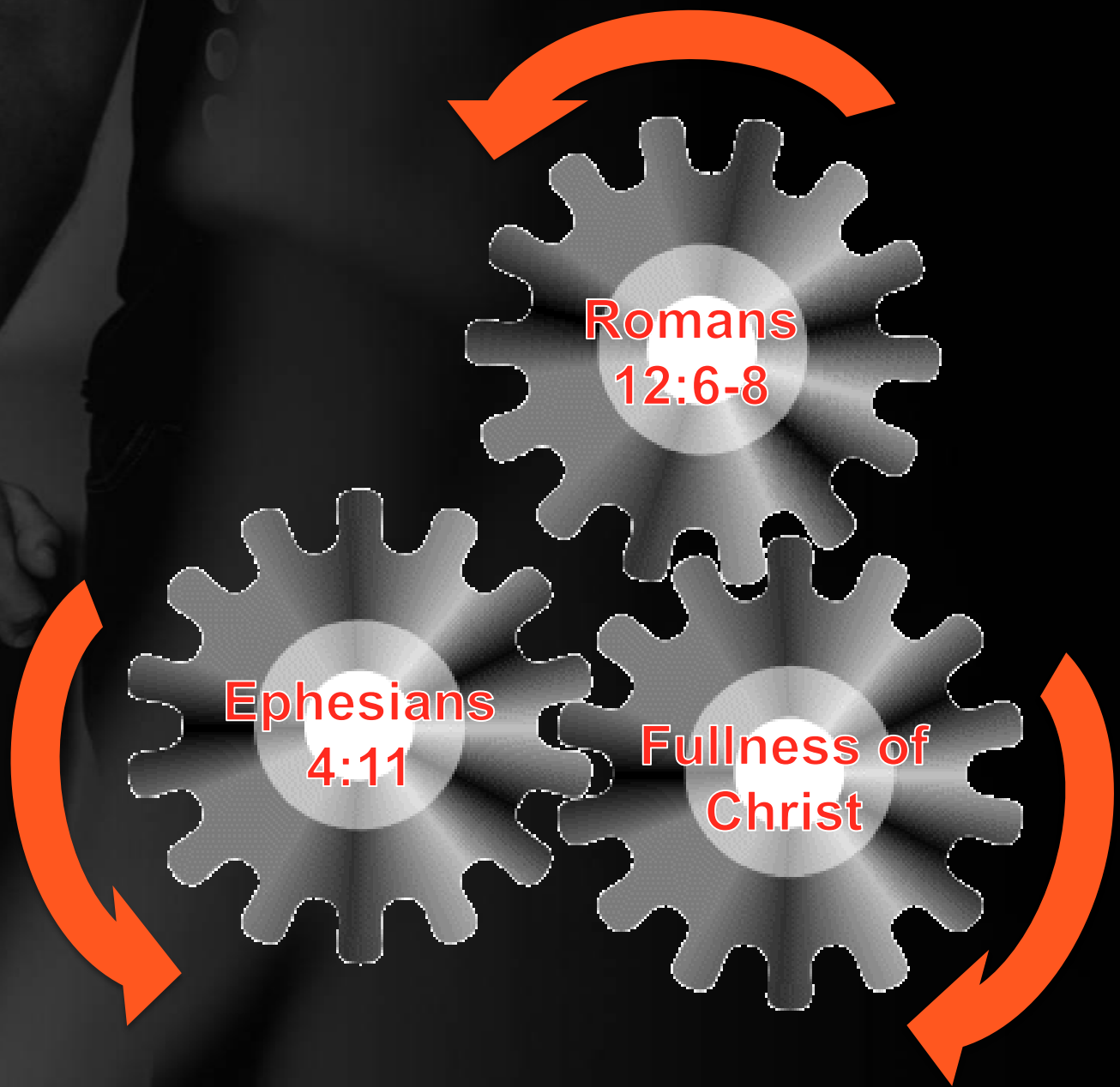
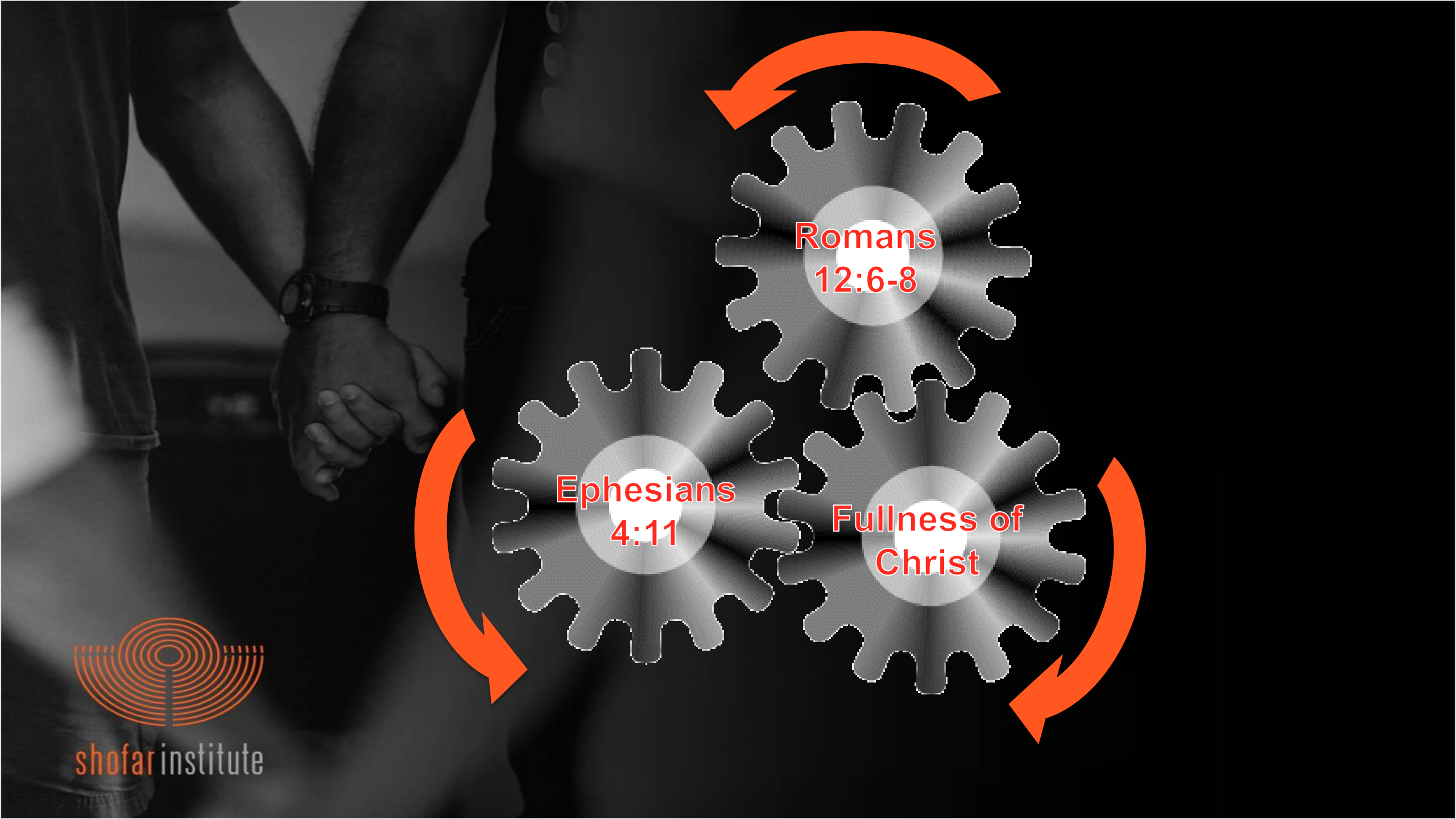


