EPHESIANS 3:8-10 (ESV)

⁸To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, 9 and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in[a] God, who created all things, 10 so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.



Exegesis:

o is the careful, systematic study of the Scripture to discover the original, intended meaning;

Hermeneutics:

- seeking the contemporary relevance of ancient texts;
- To ask the questions about the Bible's meaning in the "here and now"



Eisegesis:

o The opposite of exegesis, meaning "take out of" is eisegesis meaning "to put into" o Exegesis embodies all that is good in Biblical interpretation and eisegesis all that is bad;

o All false interpretation of the Bible is eisegetical and imposes the reader's biases and misconceptions on the text.



Martin Luther: We must not make God's Word mean what we wish. We must not bend it, but allow it to bend us, and give it the honour of being better that we can make it.

³For I say, through the grace given to me, to <u>everyone</u> who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.



⁴Just as <u>each of us</u> has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵so in Christ we who are many form one body, and <u>each member</u> belongs to all the others.



⁶We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his faith. ⁷If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; let him do it cheerfully.



⁸if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.
