





Jonah 1: 1-2


¹ The word of the LORD came to Jonah son of Amittai: ² "Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me."

- The place God calls where you don't want to go?










Jonah 1: 3


2. When we run from God.....


- We will always go down....

- We will hurt those around us.




















Jonah 4: 1-3
