So how are we to set out Bible reading so that we read and think in dependence on God's supernatural help at every moment?

John Piper's acronym A.P.T.A.T. gives practical steps to walk in God's power whenever you open your Bible: *Admit* you can do nothing without God (John 15:5). *Pray* for help (Psalm 50:15). *Trust* a specific promise (2 Chronicles 20:20). *Act* (Philippians 2:12–13). *Thank* God for his provision and goodness (Psalm 106:1). ³Jesus answered him, "I assure you and most solemnly say to you, unless a person is born again [reborn from above—spiritually transformed, renewed, sanctified], he cannot [ever] see and experience the kingdom of God."

¹² Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God. ¹³ And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.[a] ¹⁴ The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.
