**Remember: Galatians 4.....**<sup>4</sup> When the time came to completion, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba, Father!" 7 So you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

## 1. Scriptures: Jesus' Story

Luke 2: 41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover. <sup>42</sup> And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast. 43 And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not of it. 44 But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintance.

<sup>45</sup> And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.

<sup>46</sup> And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

<sup>47</sup> And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.

<sup>48</sup> And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

[<sup>48</sup> When His parents saw Him, they were astonished, and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You treated us like this? Your father and I have been anxiously searching for You."]

<sup>49</sup> And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?
<sup>50</sup> And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

<sup>51</sup> And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

<sup>52</sup> And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.

### Matthew 10:34-38 (HCSB)

<sup>34</sup> Don't assume that I came to bring peace on the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. <sup>35</sup> For I came to turn

a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; <sup>36</sup> and a man's enemies will be the members of his household. Hard? That is not the heart...

## Philippians 2:13 (AMP)

<sup>13</sup> [Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure *and* satisfaction *and* delight.

## Philippians 2:13 (HCSB)

<sup>13</sup> For it is God who is working in you, enabling you both to desire and to work out His good purpose.

## **Ephesians 2:10 (HCSB)**

<sup>10</sup> For we are His creation, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time so that we should walk in them.
