2. WHAT IS PROPHECY?: 2.1 Strong's Concordance Definition: prophéteia: prophecy Original Word: προφητεία, ας, ἡ **Phonetic Spelling:** (prof-ay-ti'-ah) **Definition: prophecy, prophesying; the gift of** communicating and enforcing revealed truth. 4394 prophēteia (from 4396 /prophētēs, "prophet," which is derived from 4253 /pró, "before" and 5346 /phēmí, "make clear, assert as a priority") properly, what is clarified beforehand; prophecy which involves divinely-empowered forthtelling (asserting the mind of God) or foretelling prediction).

2.2.2 New Testament:

- Did not change after Jesus
- Reserved for priests and prophets of the Old Testament was poured out on all flesh

1Co 12:11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills. 12 For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit. 14 For the body does not consist of one member but of many.

3.1 Testimony:

- The word "testimony" Greek: *marturia* which means evidence given; record, report, testimony, witness.

 It is from this word in Greek that we get the word "martyr" which essentially means "witness".

Matthew 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. 16 You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? 17 So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. 18 A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. 19 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.20 Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.
