<u>| Corinthians | 5:36</u> (TLB)

What a foolish question! You will find the answer in your own garden! When you put a seed into the ground it doesn't grow into a plant unless it "dies" first.



The Parable of the Wheat and the Tares

- ²⁴ Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; ²⁵ but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way.
- ³⁶Then Jesus sent the multitude away and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field."
- ³⁷ He answered and said to them: "He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. ³⁸ The field is the world, the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom, but the tares are the sons of the wicked one. (Matt 13)

Jeremiah 2:21 (NKJV)

²¹ Yet I had planted you a noble vine, a seed of highest quality.
 How then have you turned before Me Into the degenerate plant of an alien vine?

How do we die?

1. Obedience

- Obedience to God: not man/ own nature/ systems and institutions
- Obedience is "dying to self"
 Marriage
 Work
 Finances
 Ministry
- Obedience will result in a harvest (Deut 28)

2. Tribulations

³³These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will^[d] have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (John 16)

²²"We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God." (Acts 14)

Tribulations: endure or overcome

- Victory only comes through battle
- Triumph only follows trial
- No testimony without a test
- Harvest only after death

Humility: the hallmark/measuring stick

"He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death."
 (Philippians 2:8 NKJV)

- Humility leads to perfect death
- Humility is the "hallmark" of "death of the self"

Paul: an example

- ²² "And now I am going to Jerusalem, drawn there irresistibly by the Holy Spirit,^[] not knowing what awaits me, ²³ except that the Holy Spirit has told me in city after city that jail and suffering lie ahead. ²⁴ But life is worth nothing unless I use it for doing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—the work of telling others the Good News about God's mighty kindness and love. (Acts 20)
- Acts 21: 12 When we heard this, we and the people there pleaded with Paul not to go up to Jerusalem. ¹³Then Paul answered, "Why are you weeping and breaking my heart? I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die in Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus." ¹⁴When he would not be dissuaded, we gave up and said, "The Lord's will be done." (Acts 21)



Corrie ten Boom's sayings

- "Worry does not empty tomorrow of its sorrow. It empties today of its strength."
- Worry is like a rocking chair: it keeps you moving but doesn't get you anywhere."
- "When I try, I fail. When I trust, he succeeds."
- If God sends us on stony paths, he provides strong shoes."

Jesus: The ultimate example

- ³ Don't be selfish; don't live to make a good impression on others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourself.
 ⁴ Don't just think about your own affairs, but be interested in others, too, and in what they are doing.
- ⁵Your attitude should be the kind that was shown us by Jesus Christ, ⁶ who, though he was God, did not demand and cling to his rights as God, ⁷ but laid aside his mighty power and glory, taking the disguise of a slave and becoming like men.^{[a] 8}And he humbled himself even further, going so far as actually to die a criminal's death on a cross.^[b]
- ⁹Yet it was because of this that God raised him up to the heights of heaven and gave him a name which is above every other name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee shall bow in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
