1. Intro: FULL FAITH

Complete trust or confidence in someone or something.. Reliance, dependence, hope, trust, belief

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.



2. The MUSTARD SEED:

Luke 17 [HCSB]

5 The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." 6 "If you have faith the size of [e-faith like] a mustard seed," the Lord said, "you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you.



2. The MUSTARD SEED...

Matthew 17 [HSCB]

14 When they reached the crowd, a man approached and knelt down before Him. 15 "Lord," he said, "have mercy on my son, because he has seizures and suffers severely. He often falls into the fire and often into the water. 16 I brought him to Your disciples, but they couldn't heal him."



17 Jesus replied, "You unbelieving and rebellious generation! How long will I be with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring him here to Me." 18 Then Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him, and from that moment the boy was healed.

19 Then the disciples approached Jesus privately and said, "Why couldn't we drive it out?"



20 "Because of your little faith," He told them. "For I assure you: If you have faith the size of [o-faith like] a mustard seed, you will tell this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you. [21 However, this kind does not come out except by prayer and fasting.]"



Matthew 17:20 [KJV]

And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

Joel 3:10 (KJV)

10 Beat your plowshares into swords and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I am strong.

2 Corinthians 12:9 (KJV)

Isaiah 53 (HCSB)
