## Prophetic, Symbolic vision

- ✓ Jesus used pictures and parables
- ✓ **GOD gives us a PICTURE**

def: GREEK prophēteía "prophet," pró, "before" and "make clear, assert as a priority"

what is **clarified beforehand**; involves **divinely-empowered forthtelling** (asserting the mind of God)


# Inside OUT | Look at the Word

## 4.1 Anchored inside

### John 14:23-24 (HCSB)

23 Jesus answered, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word. My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him. 24 The one who doesn’t love Me will not keep My words. The word that you hear is not Mine but is from the Father who sent Me.

***An anchor - a person or thing which provides stability or confidence in an otherwise uncertain situation.***




# Inside OUT | Look at the Word




# Inside OUT | Look at the Word

## 4.2 Practical

**Acts 7:54-60 (HCSB)**

**54** When they heard these things, they were enraged in their hearts and gnashed their teeth at him. **55** But Stephen, filled by the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven. He saw God's glory, with Jesus standing at the right hand of God, and he said, **56** "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!"




**57 Then they screamed at the top of their voices, covered their ears, and together rushed against him. 58 They threw him out of the city and began to stone him. And the witnesses laid their robes at the feet of a young man named Saul. 59 They were stoning Stephen as he called out: “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit!” 60 Then he knelt down and cried out with a loud voice, “Lord, do not charge them with this sin!” And saying this, he fell asleep.**




## Daniel 3:14

Nebuchadnezzar asked them, “Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, is it true that you don’t serve my gods or worship the gold statue I have set up? 15 Now if you’re ready, when you hear the sound of the horn, flute, zither, lyre, harp, drum, and every kind of music, fall down and worship the statue I made. But if you don’t worship it, you will immediately be thrown into a furnace of blazing fire—and who is the god who can rescue you from my power?”



**16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego replied to the king, “Nebuchadnezzar, we don’t need to give you an answer to this question. 17 If the God we serve exists, then He can rescue us from the furnace of blazing fire, and He can rescue us from the power of you, the king. 18 But even if He does not rescue us, we want you as king to know that we will not serve your gods or worship the gold statue you set up.”**

**... and there was no smell of fire on them.**


