2. Passover:

2.1 Passover: OLD TESTAMENT

Old testament shadows and new testament fulfilment

Where did God institute the Passover?

EXODUS 12

The Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt: 2 "This month is to be the beginning of months for you; it is the first month of your year. 3 Tell the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month they must each select an animal of the flock according to their fathers' households, one animal per household... 7 They must take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses where they eat them.

11 Here is how you must eat it: you must be dressed for travel, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. You are to eat it in a hurry; it is the Lord's Passover. 12 "I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night and strike every firstborn male in the land of Egypt, both man and beast. I am Yahweh; I will execute judgments against all the gods of Egypt. 13 The blood on the houses where you are staying will be a distinguishing mark for you; when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No plague will be among you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. 14 "This day is to be a memorial for you, and you must celebrate it as a festival to the Lord. You are to celebrate it throughout your generations as a permanent statute.

2.2. The crucifixion: NEW TESTAMENT FULFILMENT IN JESUS

 ✓ Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection took place at the time of the Passover

Matthew 26:1-2 (HCSB)

When Jesus had finished saying all this, He told His disciples, 2 "You know that the Passover takes place after two days, and the Son of Man will be handed over to be crucified."

✓ Crucifixion

Mark 15: The Death of Jesus

33 When it was noon, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. 34 And at three Jesus cried out with a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lemá sabachtháni?" which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

Resurrection - Three days later

Mark 16:3-6

They were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone from the entrance to the tomb for us?" 4 Looking up, they observed that the stone—which was very large—had been rolled away. 5 When they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; they were amazed and alarmed. "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him."

Romans 6:9

We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. 10 For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God.

Isaiah 53:5-7 (HCSB)

5 But He was pierced because of our transgressions, crushed because of our iniquities; punishment for our peace was on Him, and we are healed by His wounds. 6 We all went astray like sheep; we all have turned to our own way; and the Lord has punished Him for the iniquity of us all. 7 He was oppressed and afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth. Like a lamb led to the slaughter and like a sheep silent before her shearers, He did not open His mouth.

Isaiah 25:8 He will swallow up death for all time, And the Lord GOD will wipe tears away from all faces, And He will remove the reproach of His people from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken.

3. Death to Life:

Born-again | Spiritual Life and Eternal Life

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me will live, even though he dies. 26 And everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"

✓ EVERYTHING HE DOES IS DEATH TO LIFE

Hebrews 2:14-15

Now since the children have flesh and blood in common, Jesus also shared in these, so that through His death He might destroy the one holding the power of death—that is, the Devil— 15 and free those who were held in slavery all their lives by the fear of death.

Moreover – live in its POWER

Likewise: Luke 10:19 (HCSB) Look, I have given you the authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy; nothing will ever harm you.

John 10:10 (HCSB)

10 A thief comes only to steal and to kill and to destroy. I have come so that they may have life and have it in abundance.

Romans 8:11 (HCSB) And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, then He who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life through His Spirit who lives in you.
