## How do we walk with Christ?

• Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for *good works*, which God prepared beforehand *that we should walk in them*.

## Jesus gives the answer

<sup>28</sup> Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light." (Matt 11:18-19)



## **Yokes: religion**

## The yoke of Jesus

### Requirements

- Come: Salvation
- Submit: Baptism
- Walk: daily obedience and intimacy

### • Results

- He carries the burden
- He determines the pace: rhythm of grace
- He shows the direction
- We are gently pulled along: relaxed/joyful under God's leadership
- We can be assured that we are in God's perfect will and will reach our destination



## Requirements for being yoked with Christ -Charles Finney

- Is to accept the <u>will of God</u> for our lives
- Is to enter a voluntary state of <u>entire subjection</u> to Him
- Is <u>to commit ourselves</u> to loving, voluntary service to him
- <u>Obedience to Him</u> because we love and trust Him

### Jesus: only requirement

• <sup>25</sup> At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes. <sup>26</sup> Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. <sup>27</sup> All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. # What is not guaranteed by being yoked with Jesus

### 1. An easy road
