Luke 4:42 (ESV) And when it was day, he departed and went into a desolate place. And the people sought him and came to him, and would have kept him from leaving them.. Luke 5:16 (ESV) But he would withdraw to desolate places and pray.

Jesus – seeked first His Father


Mark 1:35 (ESV) And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed.
