Why do we speak?

Language and comprehension

Is there difference between speaking and communicating?

God speaks (to the darkness)

Gen 1:2,3 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

Omnipotent

The darkness could not stop the word of God

God speaks (to man in his darkness)

Joshua 24:2 says Abraham was born and raised in Ur of the Chaldees and his father worshiped idols.

Gen 12:1 Now the LORD said to Abram, “Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you.”

God speaks (to a nation in darkness)

God calls Moses to deliver them from bondage and
God speaks to the nation

Ex 6:6 Say therefore to the people of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.

Jesus speaks into the darkness

Mark 2:21-24,35-42

And when Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a great crowd gathered about him, and he was beside the sea. 22 Then came one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name, and seeing him, he fell at his feet 23 and implored him earnestly, saying, “My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well and live.”

24 And he went with him. While he was still speaking, there came from the ruler's house some who said, "Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?" 36 But over hearing what they said, Jesus said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not fear, only believe." 37 And he allowed no one to follow him except Peter and James and John the brother of James. 38 They came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and Jesus saw a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly.

39 And when he had entered, he said to them, “Why are you making a commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but sleeping.”

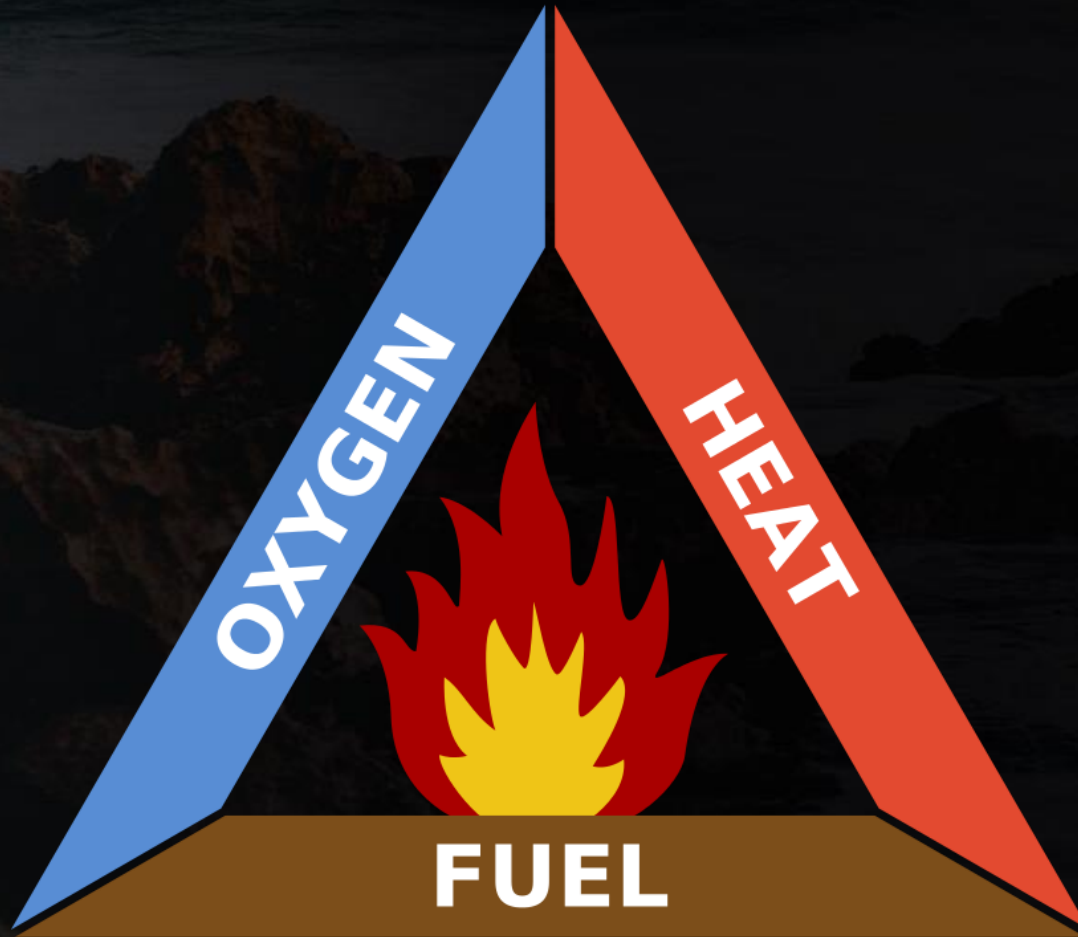
40 And they laughed at him. But he put them all outside and took the child's father and mother and those who were with him and went in where the child was. 41 Taking her by the hand he said to her, “Talitha cumi,” which means, “Little girl, I say to you, arise.” 42 And immediately the girl got up and began walking

Jairus had 3 characteristics that moved
Jesus to speak a word into his life

1. Belief (That he is who He says he is)
2. Action (Left the situation to find Him)
3. Lowly (He went “naked”)

Light Triangle

Fire Triangle



Jesus used 2 opportunities of resistance
to speak into his life

1. Continue to believe in me
2. The child is not dead but sleeping

Do not be discouraged
Trust Jesus, not the report



Jesus speaks to our darkness

REQUIREMENT: LIGHT triangle

1. Sickness or disease
2. Lack of breakthrough
3. A hurt that left us numb
4. A lie that you believe about yourself
5. Fear of man
6. Religion
