## 2. New Covenant Perks #2 | God's faithful

#### 2.1 Intro:

Reminder: A covenant is a type of relationship that is shaped by promises made to each other. These promises are held as sacred and binding, even to the point of death.

A Covenant fosters trust and longevity of such a relationship.

Covenant is the nature and basis of our relationship with God.

Covenant God. It's beautiful and not hard and cold.

Covenant always has three elements:

- 1. **Promises He promise to be our God, protect etc**Out of Hebrews 9:11-28
  - a. cleanse us from our sins
  - b. purify our conscience
  - c. enable us to serve God
  - d. give us an eternal inheritance
- 2. Sacrifice last week: Christ paid
- 3. Sign His Spirit

# **God's Faithfulness**

#### 2.2 We need God:

Faithfulness of man?

Man, good? [Mark 10:17-18]

**Psalm 143:2** Do not bring Your servant into judgment, for no one alive is righteous before You.

Romans 3: 10 As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one.



**Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV)** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

# So: Faithfulness is not of me and my flesh, but of Him, His covenant and Spirit!

**2 Timothy 2:10-13** Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. 11 The saying is trustworthy, for: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; 12 if we endure, we will also reign with him; if we deny him, he also will deny us; 13 if we are faithless, he remains faithful—for he cannot deny himself.



## 2.3 New Covenant and God's faithfulness:

2 Thessalonians 3:3 The Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one.

**Psalm 91:4 (TPT)** His massive arms are wrapped around you, protecting you. You can run under his covering of majesty and hide. His arms of faithfulness are a shield keeping you from harm.

Psalm 33:4 For the Word of the Lord is upright, And all His work is done in faithfulness.



**Ezekiel 36:24** "'For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries and bring you back into your own land. 25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. 26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. 28 Then you will live in the land I gave your ancestors; you will be my people, and I will be your God. 29 I will save you from all your uncleanness. I will call for the grain and make it plentiful and will not bring famine upon you.



## 3. How do we receive?

... Walk in this faithfulness of God.

Romans 8:28 (TPT) So we are convinced that every detail of our lives is continually woven together to fit into God's perfect plan of bringing good into our lives, for we are his lovers who have been called to fulfill his designed purpose.

Romans 8:28 (HCSB) We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God: those who are called according to His purpose.



## 3. How do we receive? [Walk in this faithfulness of God.]

## Seeing the faithfulness of God, a couple of thoughts:

- 1. Humble myself, Fear of the Lord eyes off me
- 2. Believe in Jesus [new covenant] eyes on Him
- 3. Confess and return [relationship]
- 4. Obedient to the inner work of the Spirit of God in my life...

  The Spirit of faithfulness
- 5. Do not give up [lose faith]
