Authority

The power and right to give orders, make decisions and enforce obedience.



The Power and Right Luke 10:19

I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.



The Power and Right Ps 8:6-8

You have made them a little lower (in placement) than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet

Make Decisions

- Our measure of success in reinforcing our authority is directly linked to our ability to make decisions of obedience to advance the Kingdom of God.
- The most dangerous soldier is the one that breaks his alliance with his government. There are only two sides – light and darkness. Even sitting on the fence and being passive is a win for the enemy.



2 Cor 10:3-5

For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. ⁴ The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. ⁵ We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.



Strongholds are bricks built by thoughts to give a place for either the enemy to occupy a certain area of your life if it is built on lies or for the Holy Spirit to dwell and empower if it is based on truth.



Our mandate is to actively break it down, arrest every invading thought, tie them down, bring them to the obedience to the truth of Jesus Christ and replace it will the truth of Christ. We do it by using the weapons God has given us.



It is lie-based thinking, default landing strips of your thoughts that is not rooted in Christ. We use our authority to swiftly deal with wrong thinking so that the only commands we give will be from a place of fullness in Christ. The only decisions we make will be based on reality and not lies.
