Author of LIFE: the Trinity

1.1 Holy Spirit

John 6:63 The Spirit is the One who gives life. The flesh doesn't help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.





Romans 8 The Holy Spirit Gives Life

Those who belong to Christ Jesus are no longer under God's judgment. 2 Because of what Christ Jesus has done, you are free. You are now controlled by the law of the Holy Spirit who gives you life. The law of the Spirit frees you from the law of sin that brings death.

1.2 God the Father:

Genesis 2:7 Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.



Psalm 16:11 You reveal the path of life to me; in Your presence is abundant joy; in Your right hand are eternal pleasures.

1 Timothy 6:13 In the presence of God, who gives life to all, and of Christ Jesus, who gave a good confession before Pontius Pilate, I charge you...

1.3 Jesus:

John 1:3-4

2. Seed of LIFE:

Seed, definition:

- the unit of reproduction of a flowering plant, capable of developing into another such plant.
- a small, round or oval object produced by a plant and from which,
 when it is planted, a new plant can grow.
- Sperma G4687; something sown, that is, seed (including the male "sperm"); by implication offspring;

1 Corinthians 3:6-9
