# 1. Life, Love and Context:

## 1.1 Why is Seed and Sowing important again?

*Let's Chat...*

Seeds, symbolic

All of life

All of who we are and what we do

Similar to: 'Cause and effect'

Why it is important?



## 1.2 Sow along the lines of LOVE:

*Today's key*



Remember the first Sower, God:

**John 3:16** “For God loved the world in this way...”

**Am I loving through the sowing of my life?**

**Matthew 22:36-40** “Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?” 37 Jesus replied: “‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.”



**1 John 4:7** "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God."

**John 15:12** "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."





*"The acid test of wise sowing is LOVE"*

- Am I loving God and...
- Am I loving others in what and how I'm sowing?

## 2. Team is key in 'Seeds and Sowing':

*Love key* Team, family, body



Revisit Scripture:

### 1 Corinthians 3: The Role of God's Servants

5 What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? They are servants through whom you believed, and each has the role the Lord has given. 6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. 7 So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. 8 Now the one planting and the one

watering are one in purpose, and each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. 9 For we are God's coworkers. You are God's field, God's building. 10 According to God's grace that was given to me, I have laid a foundation as a skilled master builder, and another builds on it. But each one must be careful how he builds on it. 11 For no one can lay any other foundation than what has been laid down. That foundation is Jesus Christ. 12 If anyone builds on that foundation with gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay, or straw, 13 each one's work will become obvious, for the day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire; the fire will test the quality of each





one's work. 14 If anyone's work that he has built survives, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone's work is burned up, it will be lost, but he will be saved; yet it will be like an escape through fire.



### 3. Don't eat your sowing seed:

*Love key*



#### **2 Corinthians 9: KINGDOM HARVEST**

6 Remember this: The person who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the person who sows generously will also reap generously. 7 Each person should do as he has decided in his heart—not reluctantly or out of necessity, for God loves a cheerful giver. 8 And God is able to make every grace overflow to you, so that in every way, always having everything you need, you may excel in every good work. 9 As it is written: He scattered; He gave to the poor;

His righteousness endures forever. 10 Now the One who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness. 11 You will be enriched in every way for all generosity, which produces thanksgiving to God through us.



- **Emphasise** | All of life's seeds

## Love key



10 Now the One who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness.

- Humility | His Grace
- Both seed and bread
- What to eat and what not to eat?
  - **LOVE IS TO BE FED** and be **SATISFIED, BUT TO SOW your seed in LOVE**
