


Greek: Thlipsis

From G2346; pressure (literally or figuratively): - afflicted, (-tion), anguish, burdened, persecution, tribulation, trouble.

2.2 In Me | PEACE:

"Being a disciple of Jesus Christ is not easy. God's salvation may be free, but discipleship is costly. The gifts of the Spirit may also be freely given, but they are not cheap. Christ is the Prince of Peace!"

IN ME -

<u>Peace</u> = eirēnē l Probably from a primary verb εἰρω eirō (to join); peace (literally or figuratively); by implication prosperity: - one, peace, quietness, rest, + set at one again.

- Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD delivers [us] out of them all. **Psalm 34:19**
- The peace of God is one of the key indicators of God's guidance. Colossians 3:15 tells us to let the peace of God rule in [our] hearts.
- You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You. Isaiah 26:3
- Condition: to trust in God. Romans 8:6

3.1 Overcoming | Definition:

Greek: Overcome: νικάω l nikaō l nik-ah'-o From G3529; to subdue (literally or figuratively): - conquer, overcome, prevail, get the victory.

"to defeat, to win a victory over, as in a contest or military conflict."



3.2 Overcome what?

- Relational Separation I God and His Children
- Anxieties and cares: Christ's victory over the world is multifaceted. John 14:27
- Hatred and persecution: **John 15:18–20**; "is greater than the one who is in the world" **1 John 4:4**
- Sin and temptation: Temptation to sin will always be a part but Christ gives us victory over sin. **Ephesians 2:3; 2:4–6**
- Spiritual forces: Colossians 2:15; Hebrews 2:14; Ephesians
 6:10–18
- Sorrow and death: 1 Corinthians 15:26–27; 1 John 5:4–5
