1. Why Church?

Our intentions do not determine our life, but our habits...

1.1 Revelation of Jesus and a Love for Jesus:

Grow in Christlikeness and live like Him

Matthew 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.

John 14:15 "If ye love me, keep my commandments."

1.3 The Authority of the Word:

We obey the Word of God! Scripture calls us - Church family:

Acts 2:41-46 NLT 41 Those who <u>believed</u>... were <u>baptized</u> and added to the <u>church</u>... 42 All the believers <u>devoted</u> themselves to the apostles' <u>teaching</u>, and to <u>fellowship</u>, and to <u>sharing</u> in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to <u>prayer</u>...44 And <u>all the believers</u> <u>met together</u> in <u>one place</u> and shared everything they had... 46 They <u>worshiped</u> together at the <u>Temple</u> each day, met in <u>homes</u> for the Lord's Supper, and <u>shared</u> their meals with great <u>joy and generosity</u>

2. Radical Biblical Hospitality:

An uncompromising key to Church, life and being able to connect, grow and love, is to be a people that is hospitable.

Letting others in and also being able to enter in and share

2.1 Beginning and the End:

Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. 28 And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Revelation 3:20 ESV Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.

2.2 Definition:

Hospitality I **friendly and generous reception** and *entertainment of* guests, visitors, or strangers.

[*Sharing Christ with...]

<u>friendliness</u>, hospitableness, <u>welcome</u>, <u>warm reception</u>, <u>helpfulness</u>, <u>neighbourliness</u>, warmth, <u>warm-heartedness</u>, <u>kindness</u>, kind-heartedness, congeniality, geniality, <u>sociability</u>, conviviality, cordiality, amicability, amenability, <u>generosity</u>, <u>liberality</u>, bountifulness, <u>open-handedness</u>.

GREEK I Philoxenos From G5384 and G3581; fond of guests, that is, hospitable: - given to (lover of, use) hospitality.

Philonexia hospitableness: - entertain strangers, hospitality.

"Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. Show hospitality to one another without grumbling" 1 Peter 4:8-9

2.3 Testimonies:






