Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Three ways of responding to God's Promises

- 1. Eliezer (Gen 15)
- 2. Ishmael (Gen 16)
- 3. Isaac (Gen 17)

Three ways of responding to God's Promises

- 1. Eliezer (sight) 'behold, Lord'
- 2. Ishmael (flesh) 'go in to'
- 3. Isaac (faith) 'fell to his face'

- 1. Eliezer 2 Cor 5:7 for we walk by faith, not by sight.
- 2. Ismael Gal 3:3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?
- 3. Isaac 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness.

The fruit

- 1. Eliezer Settle for less
- 2. Ishmael Strife & pain
- 3. Isaac Glory & awe!
