

“Research shows that the public across all regions and demographics – *almost 30 000 people in 31 countries* – largely feel that they cannot keep up with a fast-changing world: nearly eight in ten people worldwide (78%) believe that “the world is changing too quickly for me,” indicating an overall **sense of anxiety** in this current state of **polycrisis***.

People are feeling **overwhelmed** with the pace and intensity of change.”



Matthew 7:24-27 | Build Your House on the Rock




1 John 3:1 "See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God."

→ We have to personally hear it from God




John 15:9 "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love."

Mark 10:46-52 A Blind Man Healed

46 They came to Jericho. And as He was leaving Jericho with His disciples and a large crowd, Bartimaeus (the son of Timaeus), a blind beggar, was sitting by the road. 47 When he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he began to cry out, “Son of David, Jesus, have mercy on me!” 48 Many people told him to keep quiet, but he was crying out all the more, “Have mercy on me, Son of David!” 49 Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.” So they called the blind man and said to him, “Have courage! Get up; He’s calling for you.” 50 He threw off his coat, jumped up, and came to Jesus. 51 Then Jesus answered him, “What do you want Me to do for you?” “Rabbouni,” the blind man told Him, “I want to see!” 52 “Go your way,” Jesus told him. “Your faith has healed you.” Immediately he could see and began to follow Him on the road.

Luke 7:11-17 Jesus Raises a Widow's Son

11 Soon afterward he went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him. 12 As he drew near to the gate of the town, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow, and a considerable crowd from the town was with her. 13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, “Do not weep.” 14 Then he came up and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, “Young man, I say to you, arise.” 15 And the dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother. 16 Fear seized them all, and they glorified God, saying, “A great prophet has arisen among us!” and “God has visited his people!” 17 And this report about him spread through the whole of Judea and all the surrounding country.

Luke 23:32-55 Crucified between Two Criminals

32 Two others—criminals—were also led away to be executed with Him.

33 When they arrived at the place called The Skull, they crucified Him there, along with the criminals, one on the right and one on the left. 34

Then Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, because they do not know what they are doing.” And they divided His clothes and cast lots. 35 The

people stood watching, and even the leaders kept scoffing: “He saved others; let Him save Himself if this is God’s Messiah, the Chosen One!”

36 The soldiers also mocked Him. They came offering Him sour wine 37 and said, “If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself!” 38 An

inscription was above Him: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. 39 Then one

of the criminals hanging there began to yell insults at Him: “Aren’t You the Messiah? Save Yourself and us!” 40 But the other answered,



rebuking him: “Don’t you even fear God, since you are undergoing the same punishment? 41 We are punished justly, because we’re getting back what we deserve for the things we did, but this man has done nothing wrong.” 42 Then he said, “Jesus, remember me when You come into Your kingdom!” 43 **And He said to him, “I assure you: Today you will be with Me in paradise.”**
