2. Scripture:

Matthew 5:13-16 Believers Are Salt and Light

13 "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt should lose its taste, how can it be made salty? It's no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled on by men.

14 "You are the light of the world. A city situated on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 No one lights a lamp and puts it under a basket, but rather on a lampstand, and it gives light for all who are in the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before men, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

Matthew 5:13-14 (AMP)

13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has lost its taste **(purpose)**, how can it be made salty? It is no longer good for anything...

3. Salt:

13 "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt should lose its taste, how can it be made salty? It's no longer good for anything but to be thrown out and trampled on by men.

- preservative to save
- 'Salt of the Earth' | Meaning: According to Dictionary.com, salt of the earth means "an individual or group considered as representative of the best or noblest elements of society."

- 1. <u>Preservative Influence</u>: Salt was used to preserve food from decay. Similarly, Jesus preserves us and calls His followers to act as a preserving influence on the world, counteracting moral decay and corruption.
- 2. **Seasoning and Flavor**: Salt adds flavor to food. In the same way, Christians are called to bring life and an enriching influence to the world, making it like the Kingdom. SALT TOUCHES EVERYTHING
- 3. <u>Purification</u>: Salt was also used for purification purposes. Jesus brings us into righteousness and calls his followers to bring moral purity and righteousness to the world.

4. Light:

14 "You are the light of the world. John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Verse: 14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.
