



3.1 Life-giving:

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 All things were created through Him, and apart from Him not one thing was created that has been created. 4 Life was in Him, and that life was the light of men. 5 That light shines in the darkness, yet the darkness did not overcome it.

Time with God I Gives life I Gives light, exposes darkness

2 Timothy 4:3-4 For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having <u>itching ears</u> they will accumulate for themselves <u>teachers</u> to <u>suit their own</u> <u>passions</u>, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths.

3.3 Inspired and Authoritative:

2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, [All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable] and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof [rebuke], for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Proverbs 30:5 "Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him."


Matthew 28:18 Then Jesus came near and said to them, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go, therefore, and make disciples..."

3.4 Powerful, Effective and Transformative:





Ephesians tells us about our Spiritual battle and verse 17 makes it clear:

"and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God"

Hebrews 4:12 "For the word of God is <u>living and powerful</u>, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

Isaiah 55:11 "So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but <u>it shall accomplish</u> what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."





Romans 12:2 "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the <u>renewing of your mind</u>."

James 1:21-22 "Receive with <u>meekness the implanted word</u>, which is able to save your souls. But be <u>doers of the word</u>, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."
