



2.1 As His child



Matthew 3:17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

Belonging and identity is key to prayer and spiritual growth:



To belong is to be accepted. To belong is to feel secure. Without belonging, we are alone. As humans, our greatest desire is to know and be known, to love and be loved and to feel confident that those who know and love us will be there for us through joy and trouble.

2.2 To belong and to pray like Jesus:



1. A Son I Daughter:

Galatians 4:7 Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

Romans 8:15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

Matthew 6:9 "Therefore, you should pray like this: Our Father in heaven..."

Intimacy with the Father: Jesus as a Son



Jesus often withdrew to solitary places to pray - Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed.

This reflects His deep communion with God and reliance on the Father for guidance and strength -

John 5:19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner."

2. Accepted:



I pray not for acceptance – **but from ACCEPTANCE** - a place of belonging, righteousness and being washed by the blood of Jesus

2 Corinthians 6:18 And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

Not performing, but partnering I BELONGING

3. Access:



EVERYONE, through Jesus, have access - ALWAYS, EVERYWHERE

Matthew 27:51 Then, behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth quaked, and the rocks were split...

Ephesians 2:18 For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.

TALK to Him

Frequency and Priority: Jesus prayed frequently, including early mornings -



Mark 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

And before major decisions, such as choosing the disciples Luke 6:12 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God.



"Jesus knew that apart from continual dependence on His Father, He could do nothing. If the Son of God needed to pray continually, how much more must we?"

- John Piper emphasizes that prayer was not occasional for Jesus but a continual rhythm

4. Available:



Matthew 28:20 "Teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
