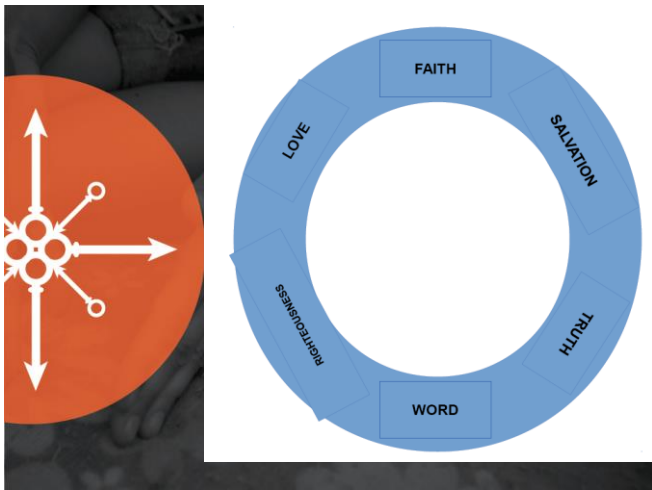




### Complete Armour of God

Ephesians 6: 13

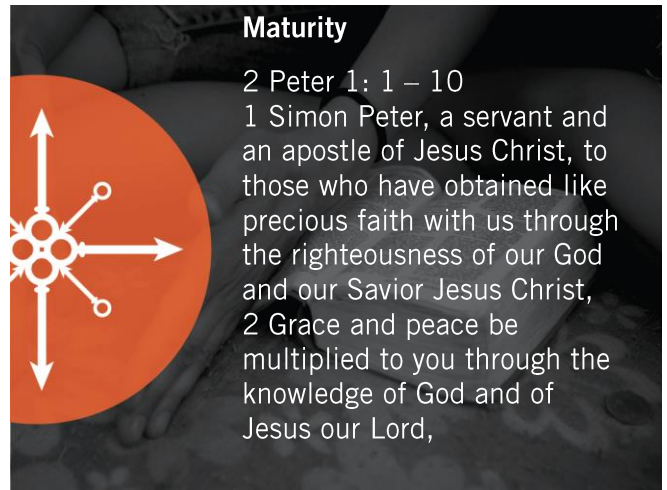
Therefore take to yourselves the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

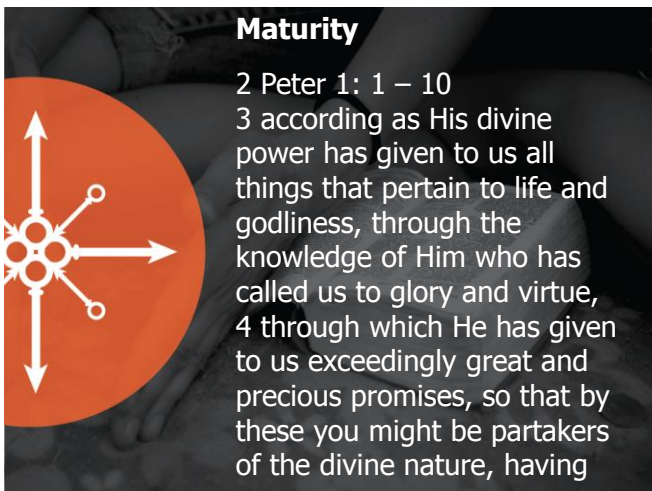

4 through which He has given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, so that by these you might be partakers of the divine nature, having




5 escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

7 and to knowledge self-control, and to self-control perseverance (patience), and to perseverance (patience) godliness,







 10 Therefore, brothers, rather be diligent to make your calling and election sure, for if you do these things, you shall never fall.




**Faith**

Complete trust or confidence in God, in His Word and in His actions.




**Virtue**

Behaviour showing high moral standards. A quality considered morally good or desirable in a person



**Knowledge**

Information and skills acquired through experience or education; the theoretical or practical understanding of a subject



**Self-control**

the act of denying yourself; controlling your impulses




**Perseverance**
