




¹¹ And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.




John 4:1-42 (ESV)



 35 Do you not say, ‘There are yet four months, then comes the harvest’? Look, I tell you, **lift up your eyes, and see** that the fields are white for harvest.




1 Corinthians 1:27-29 (ESV)

 10 For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.




**LIES WE BELIEVE
