Jesus and the Woman of Samaria

²⁵The woman said to him, "I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things."

²⁶Jesus said to her, "**I who speak to you am he.**"

²⁷Just then his disciples came back. They marvelled that he was talking with a woman, but no one said, "What do you seek?" or, "Why are you talking with her?"

²⁸So the woman left her water jar and went away into town and said to the people,

²⁹ "Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?" ³⁰ They went out of the town and were coming to him. ³¹ Meanwhile the disciples were urging him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." ³² But he said to them, "**I have food to eat that you do not know about.**" ³³ So the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought him something to eat?" ³⁴ Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work.

Citizenship: A person owing loyalty to and entitled by birth to naturalization to the protection of a state or nation

Ambassador

1. A diplomatic official of the highest rank appointed & Accredited as representative in residence by one government or sovereign state to another usually for a specific length of time
2. An Authorized messenger or representative.

The Excuses of Moses Exodus 3

- ¹¹ But Moses said to God, "Who *am* I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?"
- ¹³ Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, *when* I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What *is* His name?' what shall I say to them?"

The Excuses of Moses Exodus 4

- ¹ Then Moses answered and said, "But suppose they will not believe me or listen to my voice; suppose they say, 'The LORD has not appeared to you.'"
- ¹⁰ Then Moses said to the LORD, "O my Lord, I *am* not eloquent, neither before nor since You have spoken to Your servant; but I *am* slow of speech and slow of tongue."

The Excuses of Moses Exodus 4

- ¹³ But he said, "O my Lord, please send by the hand of whomever else You may send."
