## Operation Andrew as example

Joh 1:40 One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

Joh 1:41 He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ).

Joh 1:42 He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas" (which means Peter).

Joh 1:43 The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, "Follow me."

Joh 1:44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Joh 1:45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

## What happened?

John had spoken to his friend Andrew.

Andrew spoke with his brother Simon.

Jesus found Phillip and Phillip connected with a friend, Nathanael.

- Pray and ask-write names on their Operation Andrew cards of friends, family, or neighbors who are lost.
- Hold prayer time for the people listed on cards.
- Ask God for opportunities to invite people to "Bring a Friend" Sunday.
- Use a simple prayer: "Open my eyes, open their hearts, open my mouth."

Luk 7:39 Now when the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, he would have known who and what sort of woman this is who is touching him, for she is a sinner."

Luk 7:40 And Jesus answering said to him, "Simon, I have something to say to you." And he answered, "Say it, Teacher."

Luk 7:41 "A certain moneylender had two debtors. One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty.

What God can do...

**Abubakar Shekau-Boko Haram...** He had claimed to be waging a  Jihad  against Christianity

**Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi**  Amnesty International  has held ISIL responsible for the  ethnic cleansing  of ethnic and religious minority groups in northern Iraq on a "historic scale". In a special report released on 2 September 2014, it describes how ISIL has "systematically targeted non-Arab and non-Sunni Muslim communities, killing or abducting hundreds, possibly thousands, and forcing more than 830,000 others to flee the areas it has captured since 10 June 2014". Among these people are  Assyrian Christians  control

**Act 8:1** And Saul approved of his execution. And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.

Act 8:2 Devout men buried Stephen and made great lamentation over him.

Act 8:3 But Saul was **ravaging** the church, and entering house after house, he dragged off men and women and committed them to prison.

- violently destructive effect
- cause severe and extensive damage to.

**Act 9:1** But Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest

Act 9:2 and asked him for letters to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the Way, men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.

1Co 15:9 For I am the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

"His purpose ... was to allow Paul to become the 'chief of sinners' and then save him, and make him the apostle who would write thirteen books of the New Testament,"

"Why? Why do it this way? Why choose him before birth to be an apostle? Then let him sink into wicked and violent opposition to Christ? And then save him dramatically and decisively on the Damascus road?"

Because God wanted to encourage those who thought they were "too sinful" to have hope and also put the perfect patience of Christ on display –

God also wanted to show the world that he saved "hardened haters of Christ" like Paul who previously murdered Christians, and show that he permitted his "much-loved elect to sink into flagrant wickedness."

**God want to change lives!!**

End with...we should never forget what was forgiven...what our debt was...and how much was forgiven...weather big or small...salvation is precious!
