**Fear Defined**

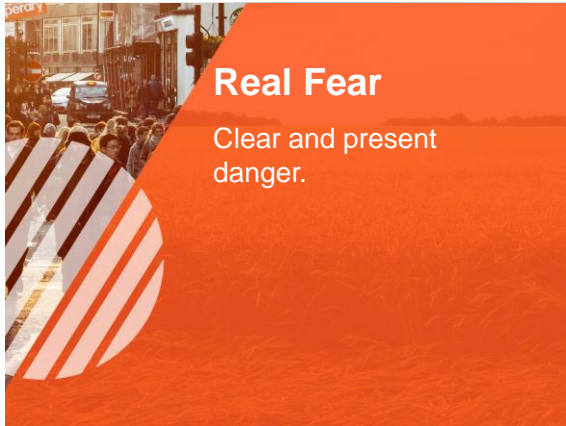
Fear - a specific instance of or propensity for such a feeling:

**Fear Defined**

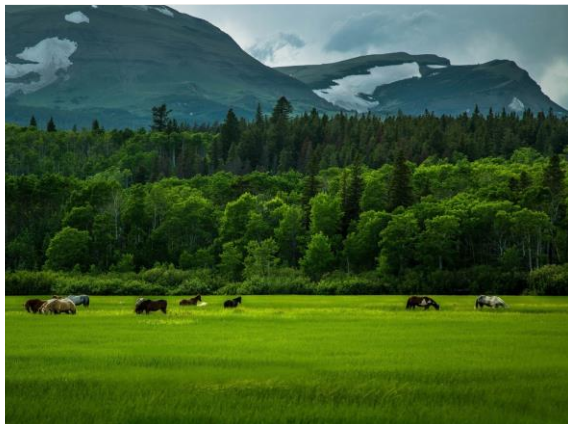
Fear - reverential awe, especially toward God:




**Job 28:28**

 from evil is understanding!




**Psalms 111:10**

 stands forever.






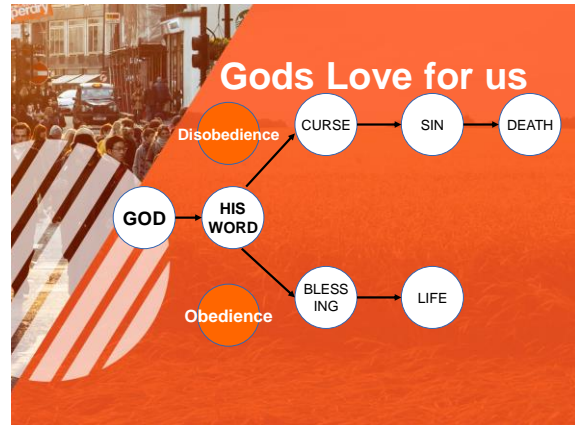

**Proverbs 1:7**  
 7 The fear of Jehovah is the beginning of knowledge; but fools despise wisdom and instruction.



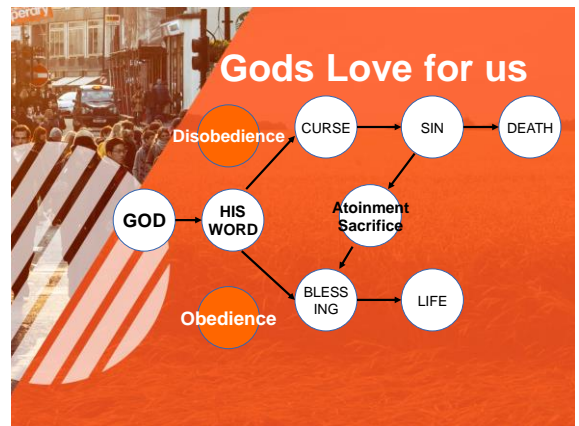
**Exodus 20:20**  
 20 And Moses said to the people, Do not fear, for God has come to test you, and so that His fear may be before your faces, so that you may not sin.




**Galatians 3:21**  
 21 Is the Law then against the promises of God? Let it not be said! For if a law had been given which could have given life, indeed righteousness would have been out of Law.





**Romans 2:4**
