- Second of the returns is 1800 people under Ezra.




Ezra 8:22




Haggai 1:4

Is it time for you yourselves to dwell in your panelled houses, and His house lie in ruins?




Matthew 13:14
Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.




JOHN PIPER




Isaiah 58

“But it would be a great mistake to think that the awakening of desire for the Bridegroom would produce a wave of monastic withdrawal into the fasting and prayer of passive waiting. That is not what the awakening of desire for Christ would produce.

It would produce a radical, new commitment to complete the task of world evangelization, no matter what the cost. And fasting would not become a pacifistic discipline for private hopes, but a fearsome missionary weapon in the fight of faith.”
